1. Welcome and Introductions:

Peter Pena called the meeting to order at 9:37 a.m. All in attendance introduced themselves.

2. Approval/Amendments of Agenda:

Jessica Etcheverry moved to approve the agenda. Kristy seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

3. Approval of minutes from December 5, 2017 meeting:

Kristy moved to approve the December 5, 2017 meeting minutes. Jessica seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

4. Old Business:

a. Project Updates-Peter with the Town of Silver City announced active projects within the town limits. These included: Silver Street project which will be getting curbing today and project completed before the end of June; College Street includes roadway reconstruction, landscape, and lighting. This project is currently waiting on SHRPO

clearance; 32nd Street is a sidewalk project which will be two blocks of sidewalk on the north side in front of the hospital which will take place from June 2018 to September 2018; Chip sealing will be taking place from July 2018 to August 5th, 2018. Bryan reported on projects in the City of Deming which included: 8th Street drainage project which is in the close out stage; Cedar Street is a sidewalk project with 60% completion done so far; Country Club drainage project is also being worked on. Jessica reported for Luna County projects which included: Phase 1 on Rockhound Road is finishing up with the drainage portion; Honduras is getting chip sealed and a couple of other streets going through a chip seal. Darlene reported the Cortez Street project is completed in the Town of Hurley. Priscilla reported there were Colonias awards for Grant County for Rosedale Road in the amount of 1.1 million dollars, Columbus Road in Catron County in the amount of 535,102 dollars. Kristy finished in reporting Maple Street and Elm Street in the City of Bayard are in the design and engineering phase.

5. New Business:

- a. Safety Target Presentation- Jolene presented on the safety target measures the NMDOT is taking.
- b. E-STIP Presentation- Jolene presented the ESTIP online and how to navigate through online website.
- c. Call for Projects-Cerisse handed out information on the call for projects from the BUILD Discretionary Grant and highlighted some key information in the handout. She also announced the call for projects for the TAP and RTP programs should be coming out within the next week.

6. Reports:

- a. Debbie announced there was capital appropriation added to the program so the requests need be requested before June 30th.
- b. Jolene added there is a new program added called the Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) program in which there will be 5 million available to entities and will be under the same eligibilities as the TAP and RTP programs.
- c. Summer with the BAG group gave a handout stating June 3rd being the designated as the World Bicycle Day. Cate added the interest for having a Bike Summit in Silver City in the year 2019 and asked for feedback for this idea.


Public Input:

There was no public input.


Adjourn:
