# VI. Presentation- Functional Classification Review (Nathan Wagliardo)

Full presentation available upon request

Method of classifying roadways- used for highway performance management reporting.

- FHWA requirement every 10 years
- Review process for NMDOT roads began April 1, 2024
- Functional Class change requests window- Oct. 21, 2024 to Dec. 31, 2024

What triggers a change in Function Class?

- Have any new roadways been constructed?
- Has a non-divided Principal Arterial roadway been reconstructed as a divided facility?
- Has a new major development been built that has changed traffic patterns?
- Has there been significant overall growth in daily traffic volumes?

# VII. Action: Safe Streets and Roads for All- Patrick Million

Million explained that the SS4A grant application will be due at the end of August. He asked that anyone who had a demonstration project associated with this grant please submit by 7/31.

Million said that this grant will result in a safety action plan for the entire NCNMEDD region. He said that entities who are not in NCNMEDDs service area could contact Samuel Jensen at NMDOT for free planning services if they also wanted a safety action plan.



Million asked for a letter of support from NERTPO and from individual members. At this point he deferred to the membership for a vote on approving a LoS for NCNMEDDs effort to secure a SS4A planning and demonstration grant for the part of NERTPO that NCNMEDD serves.

Vote resulted in the approval of a letter of support.

The significance of this was that the grant writing services used to obtain these grants (Loris Kindler, Toole Design) are available to some NERTPO members.
