

Resolution No. 22-008

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SERTPO REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN (RTP)

- **WHEREAS**, the Southeast Regional Transportation Planning Organization (SERTPO) is a regional transportation planning organization made up of local, county, and tribal governments within the counties of Chaves, Curry, De Baca, Eddy, Guadalupe (Town of Vaughn), Lea, Lincoln, Otero and Roosevelt Counties;
- WHEREAS, the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) has entered into Cooperative Agreements with the Southeastern New Mexico Economic Development District/Council of Governments (SNMEDD/COG) and the Eastern Plains Councils of Governments (EPCOG) and has provided federal financial assistance for the purpose of carrying out specific functions and tasks outlined in Regional Work Programs (RWPs);
- WHEREAS, the Regional Transportation Plan (RTP), a required document of the RWPs and the NMDOT Policy Procedures Manual (PPM), must have a review and update, in conjunction with the recent Long-Range Statewide Transportation Plan (LRSTP) or New Mexico 2045 Plan;
- **WHEREAS,** the SERTPO established a subcommittee for the purpose of reviewing an update to its Regional Transportation Plan, and the subcommittee has met virtually and in-person regarding the RTP update, in preparation for the public comment period requirement;
- **WHEREAS**, the Regional Transportation Plan update has been posted online for public comment for not less than forty-five days at http://snmedd.com/sertpo-committee/ and https://www.rtponm.org/south-east; and
- **WHEREAS**, the SERTPO Regional Transportation Plan update has been scheduled for SERTPO approval at its regular meeting on October 20, 2022, to include addressing any public comment(s).
- **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the SERTPO Committee has been provided a copy of the SERTPO Regional Transportation Plan in meeting packets; reviewed the Plan and considered any public comment(s) during the October 20, 2022 meeting; and approves the SERTPO Regional Transportation Plan update, as may have been amended.
